

## Southside Church of Christ Instructions for Entry Into The Building

There is no parking on the church parking lot due to construction of the senior housing. All persons will enter the building through the front gate on Manchester Ave. It is suggested that everyone arrive early to obtain parking on the street or valet. For those who use the valet services it is provided at no cost (tip is optional). Please arrive by 9:30am for timely entrance into worship at 10:00am. Valet service and front entrance gate will shut down at 10:15am.

### Entry to the Church

- There will be **NO** entry to the building from the parking lot. The front entry gate will be open for access to the property. This area will be operated by the Security Ushers and Hostesses will also be present to ensure that anyone trying to enter will comply with the revised COVID-19 protocol. approved by the Southside leadership.
- **Handicapped persons:** Those with difficulty walking or standing will be given priority. Once admitted, they will be directed to the westside door leading directly into the sanctuary and seated on the west side pews of the church building.
- **Walk-ins:** Once admitted to the property, walk-ins will be directed to the front entrance of the building after the Spanish congregation has concluded worship services and vacated the building, using the front entrance exiting to the sidewalk.
- At the conclusion of service, everyone who utilized valet service will be dismissed first and then everyone else will be dismissed to exit through the front door.

### Street Parking

- It is suggested that you use both sides of Manchester Ave. for parking.
- **Pedestrian traffic** is reminded to use cross walks at the control intersection at Manchester Ave. and Harvard Blvd. Crossing at the corners of this intersection is being emphasized, do not cross in the middle of the street.

### Valet Service

- Members who are using the valet services will park on the northside of Manchester Ave. and wait for directions from a member of the security staff to turn the corner onto Harvard Blvd.
- Valet attendants will come to the car, take your keys, give a parking receipt, and park your car.
- At the conclusion of services, members using valet services will exit the building first at which time you will give your parking receipt to the valet who will retrieve your car.
- **If you park through valet, please make sure you have your keys only. If not, please call (888) 991-6949 right now.**

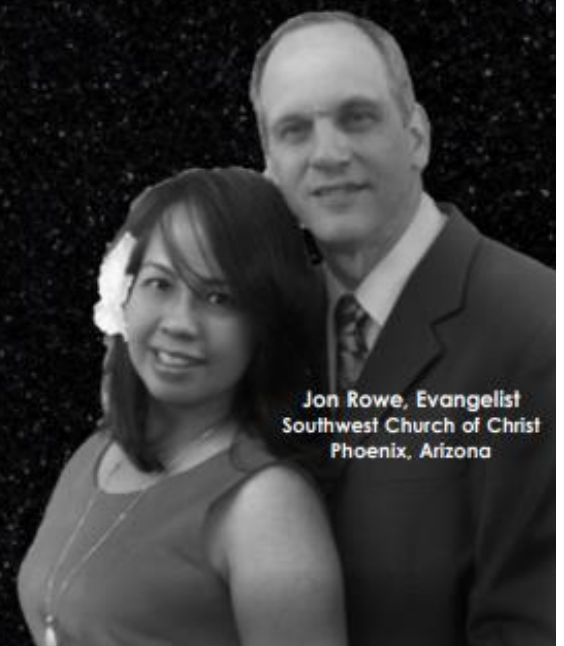

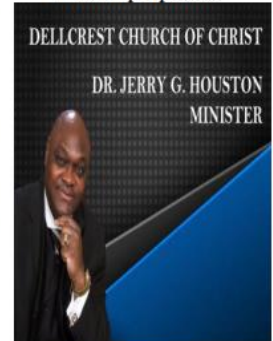
