

COVID-19 affects different people in different ways with a wide range of symptoms, ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness . Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- ❖ Fever or chills
- ❖ Cough
- ❖ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- ❖ Fatigue
- ❖ Muscle or body aches
- ❖ Headache
- ❖ New loss of taste or smell
- ❖ Sore throat
- ❖ Congestion or runny nose
- ❖ Nausea or vomiting
- ❖ Diarrhea

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

- ❖ Trouble breathing
- ❖ Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- ❖ New confusion
- ❖ Inability to wake or stay awake
- ❖ Pale, gray, or blue-colored skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone

Call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.
